In preparation for the game, choose **10 circles to draw a smiley face** in (these are your ships).

The teacher will select coordinates (bombs) by using a kanji located on the left hand side of the grid followed by a kanji on the top row of the grid (eg. 山の川).

As each "bomb" is dropped draw a cross on each of these circles.

The first person to get all their ships sunk is the winner.

Adverbs



An adverb can modify a verb, an adjective, another adverb, a phrase, or a clause. An adverb indicates manner, time, place, cause, or degree. Adverbs answer questions such as "how," "when," "where," "how much".

少し	A little 少し高いです。 <i>A little expensive</i>
とても	Very とても高いです。 <i>Very expensive</i>
あまり	Not very (only use with negative endings). あまり高くありません。 <i>Not very expensive</i>
いつも	Always いつも楽しいです。 <i>Always fun</i>

This is a simple, but very effective way to make your sentences more detailed!
